Tasks	Completed V
Introduces oneself and profession to resident/family	
Verify the resident's identity using two identifiers (e.g., name and date of birth)	
Explain reason for interview	
Asks about name and contact information of the community pharmacies	
Asks opening questions related to adherence	
Asks about resident's prescription medications : verifies medication name, dose, route, frequency, rationale for use	
Asks about recent changes to resident's medications and why	
Asks about is using any non-prescription medications : verifies name, dose, route, frequency, rationale	
Asks about using any vitamins	
Asks about using any minerals	
Asks about using any supplements	
Asks about using any eye/ear drops	
Asks about using any nose drops or sprays	
Asks about using any inhalers/sprays	
Asks about using any medicated patches	
Asks about using any medicated creams or ointments	
Asks about using any injectable medications	
Asks about receiving medication samples recently	
Asks about has recently received a course of antibiotics/antivirals in past approximately 3 months	
Asks about natural health products/complementary medicines	
Asks about cannabis	
Asks about lifestyle products/substances	
Asks if resident has any allergies/severe side effects	
Concludes interview
